

HELP US HELP THEM

ANIMALS IN ROCKINGHAM COUNTY

Due to financial constraints, Rockingham County has never had an animal shelter of its own before—they paid a veterinary office to take in the animals, but the space was inadequate and the euthanasia rate has been as high as 98% at time. The County Commissioners responded to their animals' needs and designed a great shelter, which will open in April 2011 on Cherokee Camp Road in Wentworth.



Features of the new shelter include:

- *Four times the current capacity (providing separation between animals, reduction in disrupting and stressful noise, and longer than 72-hour holding periods)**
- *Separate adoption wing and bonding areas (encouraging adoption and allow animals to be introduced to their potential owners separate from the distraction of noisy kennels and cats)**
- *Training/Education area (enabling the staff and volunteers to host adoption and fundraising events and promote responsible pet ownership through seminars).**
- *Separate HEPA filtered isolation and quarantine units (reducing the spread of disease and threat of aggressive animals)**
- Spay and Neuter Clinic (providing low cost spay/neuter services to the community)**

Rockingham County is a Tier 1 county, and with the current economic times, it does not have the money it needs to fully fit-out the new shelter. Below is a list of their needs. Donations can be specific if you want to donate certain items, or you can purchase them and deliver them or let us pick them up and transport them.
